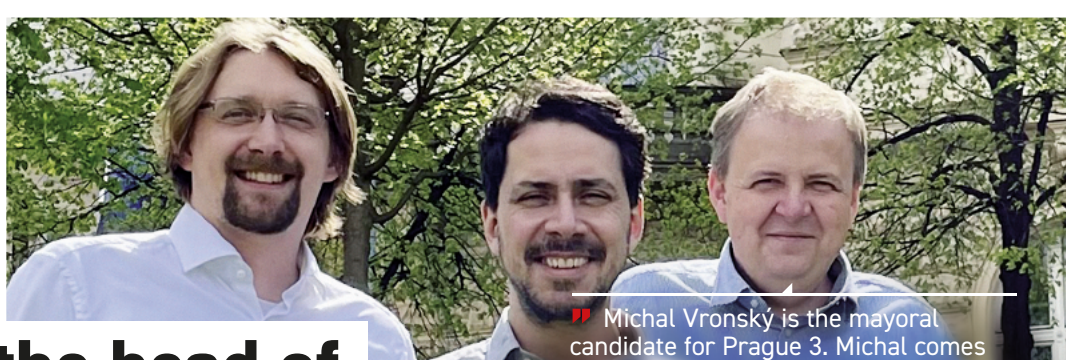

We have changed Town Hall's approach

It's not just about a new logo with three slashes, a new look for the "Radnicní noviny" or a new website. We brought the public into the game. We regularly hold meetings regarding Prague 3 projects. We have a new strategic plan for the coming years and community planning. We have established three contact centres. In addition to the town hall, you can get a lot of things done in the info centre at JzP and in Vozovna Cultural Centre in Jarov. We have introduced regular meetings with the mayor, a green information line and the Mobile Radio service.

We care for the environment

We managed to plant 300 trees in Prague 3, and in the next election period we can manage at least another 300.

We know how to arrange subsidies

Trojka began to take full advantage of subsidy opportunities – in the first three years in town hall, we brought over 650 million crowns from subsidies into its budget. This is an absolute record in the history of Prague 3.

What we focussed on



We are reconstructing one block of flats after another...

We work on tasks until the end

– We are gradually repairing all panel housing. Roháčová, Blahoslavová and Ondříčková already have a new facade. We are constructing on Táboritská Street, and before the launch, there is also the repair of the housing set on Kubelíkova street.

– We have revitalized the bike path under Vítkov, U Knežské louky park, completed Kostnické square, Barikád square and are currently repairing Žižkovo and Tachovské squares. We are starting the restoration of "Jirák" (or "JzP") square.

– We are building a children's clinic in Baranova street; repairing the office building in Seifertova street; we have completed a new kindergarten in Buková and we have opened the Žižkov museum under the town hall.

– We established a new unit of the volunteer fire brigade.

We are betting on transparency

According to the independent organization "Hlídac statu", our town hall has the lowest risk of corruption. Trojka received the best rating not only from all city districts in Prague, but essentially from all monitored town halls in the country. We have an "A" grade and an index of 1.49. This is a significant jump from 2018, when the town hall earned an index of 4.9.

We know where to save

Town hall stopped spending on unnecessary things. After ten years, it is finally not subsidizing its operation from the privatization of municipal apartments and is debt-free.

What matters to us



My family has always been inextricably linked to Tachovské náměstí. Grandma (leaning on a trash can) was among those who built the barricade during the uprising. After the war, she worked in Milič's house. She is still a source of inspiration for me.

We invested a record amount of funds in the preparation of new projects. We want to finish the work we started. Projects MUST NOT end up shelved!

– We will complete the investments we have started. We will revitalize Jirího z Poděbrad (JzP) square and implement the project of revitalizing Lobkovic Square.

– We will build Kapslovna pod Parukárkou park, which will include a forest nursery. We prepared a new skatepark in Pražacca.

– We will complete the repairs of all the block of flats. On that occasion, we will add a commercial parterre with a cafe to the panel housing on Kubelíkova street.

– We will build underground garages at Vinohradská trída. We already have the building permit and financing ready.

– We will complete the school project on Havlíckove náměstí, the new nursing home on Jarove, the Dance House on Husitská trída and the municipal apartment building on Vackove.

Responsive communication

Prague 3 Town Hall must remain open and friendly. It has proven successful for us to plan the future form of public spaces together with locals, and we intend to continue this.

Live streets

We want vibrant streets with functioning shops and businesses. We will provide non-residential premises owned by the municipality to entrepreneurs who will offer interesting and necessary services to locals. At the same time, we will increase the number of surgeries for doctors who are needed, especially for General Practitioners and paediatricians.

Kubelíkova housing – a public space where thousands of people pass every day.
